## Grammar Point

**(If Present Simple) + (Present Simple)**

You use 'Conditionals Type 0' when you want to talk about facts that are generally or always true. What happens or doesn't happen under certain circumstances.

**Examples:**

- If it snows, the ground is slippery.
- If you cool water at 0°C, it freezes.
- If you water a cactus everyday, it dies in a short time.
- A bee stings you, if you touch it with bare hands.
- You get purple, if you mix red and blue.

- You can also use "because of" to tell the reason of something but it's followed by a noun or a noun phrase.

Beauty agreed happily and they lived many long years together in the castle.

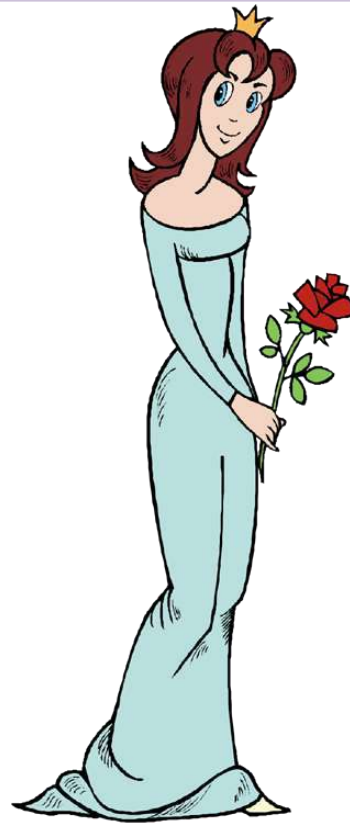

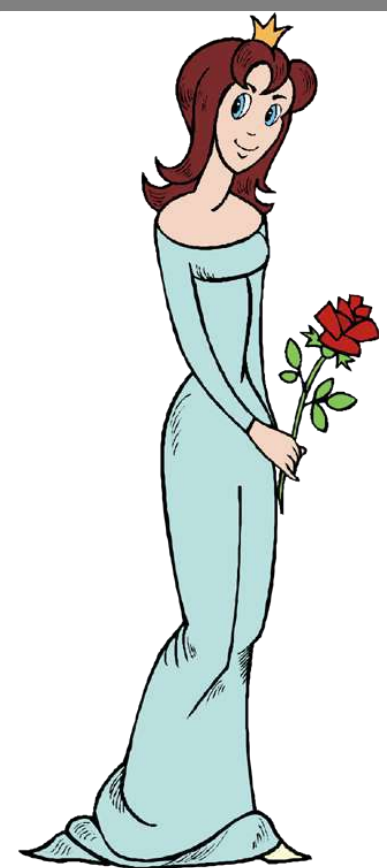
